

CATECHISM 2015-2016  
CLASS EXPECTATIONS

1. You are expected to attend every class. Class attendance is MANDATORY. If for some reason you cannot attend class on a given night let Pastor know. For instance, if you have a school function a note from your parent must be given to Pastor ONE WEEK before the absence. 2. Absence for any other function other than a school activity, illness, or family emergency is not acceptable.
3. You are expected to attend Sunday morning worship! Sunday morning worship is also MANDATORY! If you miss several weeks in a row you will receive a phone call. If you do not return and are not steady in your worship attendance you will be removed from the class.
4. You are expected to participate in class. Class participation is ENCOURAGED! In other words, Pastor expects you to answer questions – ask questions – discuss topics of interest! Those questions may not always be answered the way in which you want them to be answered, but we do our best.
5. You are expected to participate in class and small group activities. They will be a part of the learning process. Many nights will be a “hands on” class in which visuals will be used or activities done that will help in learning. Without your participation it will be no fun at all!
6. **You are expected to check your class schedule every week and be ready to give your memory work. This is not an excuse: “I didn’t know what we were supposed to memorize.” Remember: if you have any questions ask them BEFORE your memory work is due – not after!**
7. You expect Pastor to treat you with respect and treat you as a young adult and not as a child. The same goes for YOU! You are expected to treat Pastor (or any teacher) and the adult mentors with the same respect that you expect! The “Golden Rule” applies here!
8. **You are expected to be on time for class. The class begins at 6:15 PM. PLEASE BE ON TIME!!**
9. You are expected to not eat or drink during class. The classroom is not a cafeteria. Also, please do not chew gum!!
10. You are expected not to talk when others are talking. That includes Pastor!
11. You are expected to come to class every Tuesday night with a great attitude – ready to learn, listen, and discuss. Remember – if you have a problem or just need to talk I AM HERE FOR YOU AND SO IS YOUR ADULT MENTOR!
12. **You are expected to bring with you EVERY TUESDAY NIGHT a folder which will contain paper, pencil, your class schedule, and notes. Plus, don’t forget your Catechism book and your Bible!**
13. You are expected to take notes EVERY TUESDAY NIGHT!
